THEN AND NOW: COUPLE RETURNS TO COLCHESTER WEDDING RECEPTION VENUE 50 YEARS AFTER TYING THE KNOT, TO CELEBRATE GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY

On the 30 March 1968, Chelmsford couple Ian and Marjorie Warnock celebrated their wedding day with a reception at the Best Western Rose and Crown hotel in Colchester. Fast forward 50 years and the couple have returned to the venue for their golden anniversary, looking back on half a century of life together.

The pair, who have three children and seven grandchildren, have seen the world change drastically over the course of their marriage, but their love has remained unwavering.

After having the ceremony at what is now the Maldon Road Chapel in Colchester, the wedding party headed across the historic town to the traditional Rose and Crown hotel. The venue, now the Best Western Rose and Crown Hotel, is the oldest recorded hotel in Colchester, which is itself England’s oldest recorded town. Ian and Marjorie were able to toast their future among the 14th century oak beamed walls, original chimneys and small paned windows.
