Get hands-on at the King Richard III Discovery Centre, Leicester

Nearest hotel: Best Western Plus Ullesthorpe Court Hotel & Golf Club, Lutterworth

Find out more about how the 15th-century king's skeleton was discovered beneath a car park in the city in 2012. The centre charts the story of the king's life and death using interactive displays and workshops.



Breathe in the beauty of Surprise View, Peak District

Nearest hotel: Best Western Plus Buxton Lee Wood Hotel, Buxton

As the name suggests, the view here will knock you for six. It stretches out across the Hope Valley towards Chatsworth House. Take the Burbage Horseshoe walk that begins at Surprise View car park and meanders through open moor and woodland.



Watch a movie at The Kinema in the Woods, Lincolnshire

Nearest hotel: The Lincoln Hotel, Sure Hotel Collection by Best Western, Lincoln

Looking for a cinematic experience with a difference away from your local multiplex? This charming picture house is tucked away in the Lincolnshire countryside. It shows both new and classic movies, and still has an interval – so you won't miss the most important bit when you nip to the loo.



Walk among the treetops in Salcey Forest, Northamptonshire

Nearest hotel: Best Western Moore Place Hotel, Aspley Guise

The amazing Tree Top Way rises to 15 metres above the woodland floor, and you walk up steps to reach a crow's nest platform. It offers stunning views across the forest and the adjacent woodlands of Yardley Chase.







Nearest hotel: Best Western Plus West Retford Hotel, Retford

Unleash your inner Robin Hood as you have a go at traditional longbow archery in the heart of Sherwood Forest. All ages can do it – you'll learn how to load the bow and shoot your arrows through the air. But will you manage to hit the bullseye?

Step back in time at the 1620s House and Garden, Leicestershire

Nearest hotel: Best Western Sysonby Knoll Hotel, Melton Mowbray

Donington Le Heath Manor House is one of the oldest houses in Leicestershire. Built in around 1290 and updated in the 1620s, it was once owned by Sir Everard Digby, who was involved in the Gunpowder Plot. Don't miss the maze and gardens.



Tour the Royal Crown Derby factory, Derby

Nearest hotel: Best Western The Stuart Hotel, Derby Go behind the scenes of where the famous fine bone china is made, seeing how each piece is lovingly crafted. In the museum, you can see a tea set based on the one used on board the Titanic before it sank in 1912. Afterwards, enjoy tea and cakes in the tearoom.



Tee off at The Lost City, Nottingham

Nearest hotel: Best Western Plus Nottingham City Centre Hotel, Nottingham

More than just your typical crazy golf course, this indoor attraction in the basement of the Cornerhouse complex features two amazing 18-hole courses. They have interactive features such as talking Inca statues and musical landscaping.
